5. Title, number of pages and language(s) of the notified document: Draft Resolution nº 49, July 21th 2014, that disposes about the technical regulation to sanitizing products categorized as chlorine. (6 pages, in Portuguese)
6. Description of content: Draft Resolution that establishes the minimum requirements to the registration of sanitizing products categorized as chlorine. This draft resolution establishes definitions, general characters, active substances and allowed supporting of formulation, form of presentation, warnings and care to be mentioned at the labeling of the products which are categorized as chlorine, minimizing the risks to the user's health. This draft resolution applies to sanitizing products categorized as chlorine intended to disinfestation of environments, inanimate surfaces, tissues, horticultural and water to human consume and bleaching of objects, tissues, inanimate surfaces and environments. According to this draft resolution, it is prohibited the indication of: NON TOXIC, SAFE, INNOCUOUS, NO HARMFUL or others similar indications at the labeling of the chlorine. It must not contain superlative terms as THE BEST, EXCELLENT TREATMENT, INCOMPARABLE

or others similar, as well.

Are mandatory information the advertences: "DO NOT MIX WITH OTHER PRODUCTS. THE MIXING WITH ACIDS OR PRODUCTS WITH AMONIA BASIS PRODUCES TOXIC GASES"; phrases of precaution as "NOT INGEST. AVOID INHALATION OR ASPIRATION AND CONTACT WITH EYES AND SKIN."; information about first aid as: "IN CASE OF CONTACT WITH EYES AND SKIN, WASH IMMEDIATELY WITH WATER IN ABUNDANCE. IF THE IRRITATION PERSISTS, LOOK FOR A DOCTOR."

It is necessary that the labeling of chlorine contains also the telephone to toxicological emergencies – Intoxication Center (CEATOX). The number of this service (0800 722 6001) can be informed.
