6.	<b>Description of content:</b> This Inmetro Ordinance approves the partial improvement of the Conformity Assessment Procedures (RAC) for three-phase induction electric motors with squirrel cage rotor
	As established in Interministerial Ordinance no. 1, 29 June 2017, the three-phase induction electric motors with squirrel cage rotor must be manufactured, imported, marketed and refurbished for sale only in accordance with the new minimum levels of energy efficiency and within the deadlines that were fixed by it.
	Driving machines having as motor components still with the minimum levels of energy efficiency prior to the regulations mentioned in the caput, may be manufactured and imported by 1 March 2021 and marketed to the market by 30 August 2021, provided that those engines have been manufactured before the expiry of the Interministerial Ordinance no. 1, of 2017, and have been registered with Inmetro.
	The provisions contained in Ordinance Inmetro n $^{\circ}$ 488, of 2010, and the Requirements approved by it are maintained.
.7.	<b>Objective and rationale, including the nature of urgent problems where applicable:</b> Consumer protection; Performance requirements
	The need to meet Interministerial Ordinance No. 1 of June 29, 2017, signed by the Brazilian Ministers of State for Mines and Energy (MME); Science, Technology, Innovations and Communications (MCTIC) and Industry, Foreign Trade and Services (MDIC), which

approves the Program of Targets for Three-Phase Electric Motors Rotor Squirrel Cage, as provided in art. 2, §2, of Law No. 10,295 of October 17, 2001.

Following the recommendation of the Premium Motor Regulation Impact Study, Contained in the Technical Report PFP - 014/2015, coordinated by the Technical Committee of Electric Motors of the Energy Efficiency Indicators Management Committee (CGIEE), establishes new minimum nominal yields for electric motors induction three-phase squirrel cage rotor, as well as expands the scope of objects subject to regulation, extending it to fractional and power motors up to 370 kW.

The publication of brazilian technical standards ABNT NBR 17094-1:2018 (Spinning Electric Machines. Part 1: Three-phase induction motors - Requirements) and 17094-3:2018 (Rotating Electric Machines. Part 3: Three-phase induction motors - Test methods);

The need to promote Conformity Assessment Regulation alignment for three-phase electric induction motors rotor squirrel cage to updates of laws and related technical standards;

Inmetro's interactions with stakeholders since the beginning of 2018, involving government representatives, industry and laboratories, with the objective of making the necessary improvements to the RAC for Three-phase Electric Induction Engines Rotor Squirrel Cage,
