This draft Technical Regulation has the objective to establish requirements to commercialize traditional Chinese medicine products in Brazil.

It is established a period of three years from the date of publication of this Resolution for the monitoring of the use of traditional Chinese medicine products in the country.

For the purposes of this Resolution traditional Chinese medicine products are formulations obtained from vegetable and mineral raw materials in accordance with traditional Chinese medicine techniques and part of the Chinese Pharmacopoeia.

It is forbidden the use of animal origin raw material in the formulations to be

commercialized in Brazil.
