ANVISA Resolution number 432, 4 November 2020 - previously notified through G/TBT/N/BRA/608/Add.1 - which establishes the obligation to describe the composition in Portuguese on the labeling of personal care products, cosmetics and perfumes., was amended by Resolution - RDC number 499, 27 May 2021.

The new text establishes that the chemical composition in Portuguese can be presented in digital format, by reading the code on the label through a mobile device, which gives direct access to this composition and whose code is preceded by the phrase "Composition (Portuguese):" or "Ingredients (English).
