- **6. Description of content:** Inmetro Ordinance No. 247 approves the consolidation of technical quality regulation and the conformity assessment requirements for plasticized PVC hoses for domestic installation of Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG).
- 7. Objective and rationale, including the nature of urgent problems where applicable:

Decree 10.139 of 28 November 2019 provides for the need for revision and consolidation of normative acts below the decree. It aims to update and consolidate regulatory acts, elimination of obsolete regulations whose effects have been exhausted in time or the need cannot be identified. Thus, the inventories and complexity of regulatory processes will be reduced.

The potential risk and the increase in the incidence of consumer accidents caused by Plasticized PVC Hoses for Domestic Installation of Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG) and the need to ensure consumer safety with a preventing accidents approach.

The importance of plasticized PVC hoses for domestic Installation of Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG), marketed in the country to present minimum requirements for security.
