This draft Resolution applies to all products intended for children (0 – 12 years old).  This Resolution will revoke Resolution RDC n. 38, March 21 <sup>st</sup> 2001 180 days after its publication.  It will enter into force on the date of adoption.  The products manufactured according to Resolution RDC n. 38/2001 can be commercialized until the end of its expiration date.
