	"Article 1. The revalidation of the registration must be requested in advance of a maximum of twelve months and a minimum of six months of the date of maturity of the registration, being considered automatically revalidated, regardless of the decision, if it has not been rendered until the day of termination of that."
	"Art. 4 In the counting of the term to request the revalidation of the record, the final day of validity will be considered as the day of the beginning to count down the maximum advance of twelve months and minimum of six months of the day of registration, under the terms of the previous article."
	It is revoked the paragraph 3 of art. 2 of the Resolution - RDC No. 250, 2004.
